

Dear Ms. Schaefer,

I am writing to formally notify you of a decision regarding your presence on Clear Fork High School property and at school-sponsored extracurricular events. This action is being taken in response to the comments and threats you posted on Facebook, which occurred on January 23rd and 24th, 2025 and violated school board policy JFCF (Harassment).

The safety and well-being of our students, staff, and school is our highest priority. After review of the situation, the school has determined it necessary to prohibit your presence on school property, including during extracurricular activities, **effective immediately and until further notice.**

This ban includes but is not limited to:

- All school grounds, buildings, and parking lots.
- Any events hosted by Clear Fork Valley Local Schools, whether on or off campus.
- Any other activities under the supervision or authority of the school or its staff.

Should you need to communicate with the school in which your child attends, you must do so via phone or email by contacting Libby Nickoli, Butler Elementary Principal at 419-883-3451. Any attempts to access school property without prior authorization may result in legal action, including possible involvement of law enforcement.

We regret that such measures have become necessary but believe they are essential to ensure the safety and order of our school environment. If you wish to discuss this matter further, you may submit a written request to Jennifer Klaus for consideration.
